## Booking Information

### Costs for On-Site Education

There will be a minimum charge of \$100.

\$8 per student, per program with the exception of the following program:

\$10 per student - Uncover the Artist in You

(Maximum of 25 students per group/program.)

### Off Site Heritage Kit Classes

\$8 per student + \$75 travel cost within one hour of Stony Plain. (Most kits are built for a maximum of 30 students at one sitting.)

(\$30 rental fee for two week period)

**Complete Tool Box**  uses tools as a focal point for creative and critical thinking and story writing through a process of open-ended questions, discussions and interaction with materials.

**The Making Music Kit**  uses musical instruments for creative and critical thinking. Through listening and moving students will become familiar with a variety of musical instruments from other countries.

**The School Days Kit**  focuses on history, traditions, stories and the development of responsible citizenship. Examining the evolution from the one-room multi-grade school house to the technological institutions they are familiar with today.

# In our programs students will ...

## Pioneer Programs

### My Pioneer Family (Soc. St. 1.2 & 2.2)

We use our Settler's Cabin as a historical resource to show how families of the past have affected and influenced family life today.

### Pioneer Field Day (Soc. St. 1.2 & 2.2)

We use artifacts, games, and homemade treats to highlight differences between current activities and events of long ago.



## Agriculture/Environment Programs

### Terra to Table (Sci. Topic E - Soc. St. 2.1, Health W- 2.1 & 2.5)

We investigate the economic impact of the agricultural industry on the community. Focuses on growing healthy food choices.

### Green Sprouts (Sci. Topic 1E)

We recognize and identify the basic needs and interactions of plants, insects, and small animals and their role within the food chain.



## Health Programs \*

### Alberta Café! (Health W-1.5, W-2.5, & W-3.5)


We use the Canada Food Guide to recognize the importance of basic healthy nutritional choices, practice reading food labels and explore the benefits of eating locally grown foods.

## Art Programs

### Uncover the Artist in You \*

We use our current gallery exhibition to observe and reflect on artistic style, students then express their creativity through different mediums.
