CSA 2019 Agreement

Our CSA is gearing up for a 15-week season at \$33 dollars a week for a full share and \$20 a week for a half share. Although each week will be different, and it is impossible to predict what the season will bring; we are planning for at least \$45 worth of groceries in your box even in the event of crop struggles. Any additional product pulled from the garden will be divided up amongst the shares as a thank you for supporting our farm.

Additional shares: Preserved goods share

Each week you will receive 1 jar from our preserved good collection. This may include but not restricted to jams, jellies, salsa, pickles of different varieties at \$10 a week.

Choose from the following:

Full Share \$500

Half Share \$300

Preserved Goods Share \$150

All funds must be received in full via PayPal on line or in person at the front desk with cash or debit by March 31st. There are absolutely no refunds once payment has been made given what we seed, plant and harvest has been meticulously planned based on shares sold.

Terms and Conditions - Must check all to participate in the program.

I understand that by supporting Red Brick Farms I am contributing to the local food system and the sustainability of our community.

I understand that the growing season can be unpredictable with weather/pests/water as factors and can affect the outcome.

By taking on a farm-share, I am sharing in the rewards and the risks of a farm. With a great growing year comes a great bounty and with a poor growing year comes thin crops and possibly crop failure.

I understand that I will be receiving produce according to the season its harvested in and am willing to try out new and exciting recipes to go along with them.

With our seasons being unpredictable, I understand that there may be weeks shortened or lengthened due to the weather.

I will pick up my box each week or arrange with a family member/friend to pick it up. If I cannot make it, I will give the Farm Manger plenty of notice and because the items often need refrigeration, if I am unable to pick up my veggie box within 24 hours of the scheduled pickup date, I give the gardeners permission to do with it what they see fit.

I will assume responsibility on bringing a carrying device to take my share home in.
